GENERAL ORDER NO. 158

The United States District Court for District of Idaho has four statutory places of holding court. When the Coeur d'Alene Division was closed approximately 20 years ago, all case filing and dispositions for both the Northern and Central Divisions have been reported under the Central Division (Moscow).

The Coeur d'Alene Division has long since been reopened and staffed for the convenience of the bar and public. Now, the Court having an interest in accurate statistical reporting, **HEREBY** re-establishes the calendar areas for the Northern and Central divisions. Since January 1, 2000, civil and criminal cases have been assigned to the Central (Moscow) or Northern (Coeur d'Alene) Division.

Due to administrative oversight, a general order detailing these designations was never adopted. To rectify that oversight, the Court finds that in the interests of justice, **IT IS HEREBY ORDERED** that the calendar areas of the United States District Court for the District of Idaho shall consist of the following counties:

Code	Division	Office Location	Counties
2	Northern	Coeur d'Alene	Benewah, Bonner, Boundary, Kootenai, Shoshone
3	Central	Moscow	Clearwater, Idaho, Latah, Lewis, Nez Perce

IT IS FURTHER ORDER THAT THIS be adopted effective Nunc Pro Tunc to January 1, 2000. This Order shall apply only to cases filed on or after January 1, 2000 and will not affect previously pending cases. This action amends Local Rule 3.1.

Unless otherwise ordered by the Court, cases that have venue in one of the above calendar areas will be assigned by the clerk upon the filing of the complaint, petition or indictment to the appropriate calendar area. The Court reserves the right to try the case in any calendar area.
