No sooner than seven (7) days in advance of trial, the names and biographical information, excluding street address, home and work telephone numbers, and Social Security numbers, of persons impanelled for that trial drawn from the qualified jury wheel may be made public, provided that any district judge in a case where the interest of justice so requires may order that the names be kept confidential until the time of voir dire examination.
