This matter coming before the court upon the recommendation of the Clerk of Court; and


The Court having previously instructed the Clerk to eliminate the jurors addresses and telephone numbers on the jury biographical forms before releasing information to counsel, and


The Court being fully informed that the jurors right to privacy is an important right; NOW THEREFORE,

Paragraph S, on Page 10 of the Jury Selection Plan and General Order # 67, dated August 24, 1990, and amended by General Order 82, dated May 14, 1992, is hereby amended as follows:

"No Sooner than 7 days in advance of trial, the names and biographical information, excluding street address, home and work telephone numbers and social security numbers, of persons impanelled for that trial drawn from the qualified jury wheel may be provided to counsel. Any district judge, in a case where the interest of justice so requires, may order that the names be kept confidential.
