
**GENERAL ORDER NO. 313**  
SUPERSEDES AND AMENDS  
GENERAL ORDER 271

This Order hereby supersedes and amends General Order #271 entered May 22, 2013.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that out of the Two Hundred Dollars (\$200.00) collected from the Attorney Admissions Fee, that Twenty Dollars (\$20.00) will be deposited by the Clerk in the General Fund Receipt Account, One Hundred Sixty-One Dollars (\$161.00) will be deposited into the special Filing Fee Judiciary Fund established under 28 U.S.C. § 1914, and Nineteen Dollars (\$19.00) will be deposited into the District of Idaho Non-Appropriated Fund.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the entire amount of the Two Hundred Twenty-Five Dollars (\$225.00) collected from each verified petition of the Pro Hac Vice Fee be deposited into the District of Idaho Non-Appropriated Fund.
